In my position of Programme Director, I would like to formally present our new **Executive Master in EU Studies**, a programme organised by the Centre international de formation européenne (CIFE) in cooperation with the Centre for Turkish and European Studies of the University of Cologne and funded with the support of the European Commission.

The Executive Master in EU Studies offers an accurate blend of theoretical and practical knowledge with courses taught by internationally recognised experts. Individual guidance is one of the core elements of our programme, which happens both during online phases and workshops and allows the participants to pace their study according to busy work schedules.

The Executive Master programme represents an outstanding opportunity for professionals to continue studying while pursuing their career; to this aim, it is organized as a part-time programme, spread over two and a half academic years. Several scholarships are available for our candidates. The deadline for application is 5 September 2016.
